During your pregnancy there are certain tests which you may need to be done during a certain time of your pregnancy. They Are as follows:

11 Weeks 3day-13 Weeks 6days:

NTT Screening (optional)

12-14 Weeks:

Fetal Heart Rate can usually be heard.

15-20 Weeks :

Maternal Serum Quad Screening Test offered at

16-18 weeks of pregnancy (optional)

*Amniocentesis (if needed)

*Fetal Movements can be felt around 18-20 weeks

20-22 Weeks :

Ultrasound at approx 20 wks for baby's anatomy

24-28 Weeks:

Sign up for Childbirth classes (Lamaze)

28 Weeks:

1Hour glucose hemoglobin and additional labs

37 Weeks :

Discuss Scheduling Cesarean Section if required Group

B Strep Culture done . Weekly internal exams.

Delivery: Call insurance company to notify them of the delivery within 24-48 hours. Notify the insurance company to add baby to your policy. Call the office to schedule your postpartum visit.
